USEF Exhibition Status

CROSS ENTRY RESTRICTIONS: Horses may not participate in any other classes at the Pennsylvania National Horse Show, except Side-Saddle.

HUNT NOMINATION: Hunts must be nominated on the nomination form or in the form of a letter from the Master of the Hunt stating the individual or Hunt's intention to compete. Either one must be accompanied by a nominating fee of \$100 per hunt (which includes one or more individual riders and/or one or two teams). The nomination must be postmarked no later than September 9, 2019. This letter must also include the name, address and phone number of the contact person who will be handling the entries. Open to recognized hunts.

ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED BASED ON DATE OF RECEIPT OF NOMINATION FEE. Declaration forms must be RECEIVED by the horse show entry office no later than October 1, 2019. Payment in full must accompany entry.

CHANGES to an existing entry will be accepted until 3PM, October 14. Absolutely no changes will be accepted after this time.

ENTRY LIMITS: Each Hunt may enter no more than two teams. Entries in other classes will be limited as follows: Per Hunt: Field Hunter, no more than 6 horses total in both sections.

ENTRY DEADLINES:

Nomination fee of \$100.00 September 9, 2019

Late nominations will be accepted on a space available basis and with a nomination fee of \$125.

Class Entries: October 1, 2019

Entry forms must include names of all horses, riders and owners who will be competing. All riders must sign the entry blank. All other event regulations apply as set forth in the Hunter Division of the Horse Show.

STABLING: Limited overnight stabling may be available - \$125.00 per stall – from 5:00 PM Sunday night until 7:00 AM Tuesday morning. Stalls will not be cleaned between occupants.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of The Pennsylvania National Horse Show. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

Trophy to winner, Placings 1-8

To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3', similar to those that a field hunter would encounter in the hunt field. Judges on performance, manners, suitability of horse and rider and soundness. Emphasis on ability as a field hunter. Entries may be shown in only one age group.

ENTRY FEE \$40.00 per class

Trophy to winner, Placings 1-8

Open to horses & ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop collectively one way of the ring at the judges discretion, but never more than twelve at one time. To be judges on performance, manners, suitability and soundness. **HORSES MAY NOT SHOW IN BOTH THE LADIES AND GENTLEMAN UNDER SADDLE.**

Open to teams of threes horses/ponies from a Registered or Recognized pack of hounds. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3'. Each team must have at least one adult member (over 18 years of age). To be judges on a brilliant performance at a hunter pace, soundness, suitability, manners and uniformity as a team.

HUNT NIGHT CHAMPION AND RESERVE CHAMPION

The Ralph A. Alfano Memorial Perpetual Trophy donated by his family

Awarded to the two hunts which acquire the most points. Ribbons to count: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2. In the event of a tie, the award will be made jointly. Only a teams best ribbon per class will be counted.
