

PENNSYLVANIA NATIONAL HORSE SHOW

October 13-22, 2011

- All payment for entries must be received by the date indicated on your acceptance letter.
- Please make any changes necessary on your letter and adjust balance due as needed.
- Junior week stalls \$225; Senior Week Stalls \$225; FEI Stalls \$225
- Overnight stalls \$75/night – not available Oct 12-15. Overnight stalls start at 5 pm and must be vacated by 5pm the next day or when you are done showing.
- Camper spaces MUST be ordered by 10/4 to guarantee the \$350/week rate. Reservations after 10/4 may be accepted at the rate of \$500/week. Campers arriving without a reservation will be at the rate of \$700/week.

Pessoa/USEF Medal Finals Riders

- At the request of the USEF Equitation Committee, Equitation horses must be on the show grounds by noon Saturday, October 15 and remain on the grounds until 3 p.m. Sunday, October 16.
- All horses on the grounds that may participate in Medal Finals and/or the equitation schooling class, must be entered in the show office and pay the office fee to receive a number. They will also be required to provide a description of the horse and the exact stall location to the equitation representative. This must be done prior to noon, Saturday, October 15.
- Only horses with assigned show numbers will be allowed to ride during any equitation restricted times and must wear their number at all times when out of the stall.

Local Hunter Exhibitors

- All horses must be registered with USHJA. A USEF horse ID # is not enough. You can complete this and pay the \$30 fee at www.usef.org or the paperwork can be completed in the horse show office. The owner on the entry blank must match the ownership information with USHJA.
- Please verify that you meet all the requirements as listed on page 41 of the prize list.

Open Jumper Exhibitors

- Riders are limited to two (2) horses per class, except for Thursday and Saturday where riders are limited to one (1) horse.
- Riders may show no more than four (4) different horses.
- Please make sure to indicate on your acceptance letter the number of FEI stalls and the number of Senior (non-FEI) week stalls needed.
- All horses in the FEI stabling will need to have a passport even if they are not showing in either of the FEI classes (Thursday & Saturday).

Sections with Rider Limitations

- Riders showing in the pony hunters are limited to a total of three (3) ponies and no more than two (2) per height.
- Riders in the Amateur Owner Hunter, Amateur Owner Jumper, and Junior Hunter are limited to no more than two (2) per section. Please notify the office with rider changes or scratches as soon as possible.
- Additional restrictions apply to entries in the NAL Finals. Please verify on page 50-51 that you meet all cross entry restrictions.
